

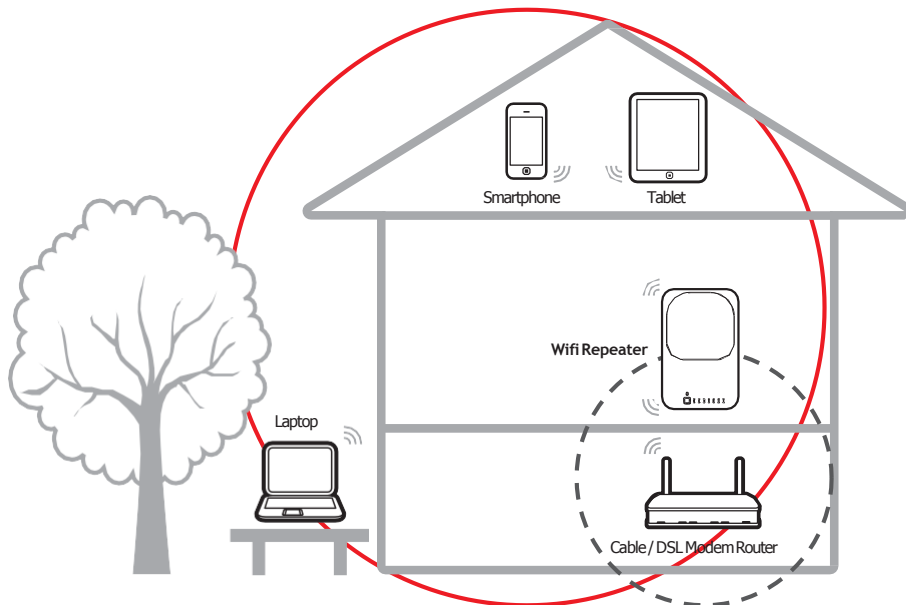

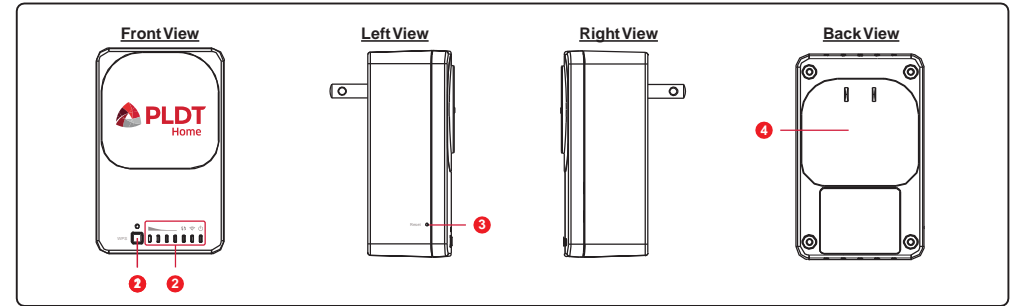

1. Overview



1 WPS : Press 1 second to trigger WPS function

3 Reset : Press 1 - 5 seconds to reboot Repeater.
Press > 5 seconds to reset to factory default and reboot.

2 LED Indicators:

-  Power : On - Power On
Off - Power Off
-  WLAN : On - Wireless turn On
Off - Wireless turn Off
-  WPS : On - WPS feature turn On
Off - WPS feature turn Off
Blinking - WPS triggering
- Signal Strength : 1 LED On : Low Signal
2 LEDs On : Medium Signal
3 LEDs On : Good Signal
4 LEDs On : Excellent Signal

3. Connecting to the Root AP

Method 1 : With WPS button

Step 1. Plug the Wifi Repeater into the electrical socket and power on the electrical socket. The Power LED  on Wifi Repeater will illuminate. Wait until the WLAN  and WPS  LEDs light up.

Step 2. Press the Wi-Fi Protected Setup (WPS) button on your wireless router or root AP.

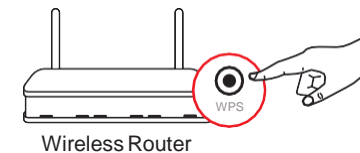
Step 3. Press the WPS button of Wifi Repeater for 1 second until the WPS  LED starts to blink.



Note 1. The Signal Strength LEDs will illuminate to show the link quality once connected to the root AP.

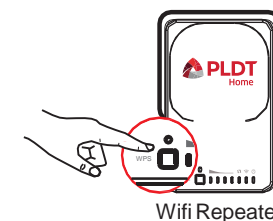
Note 2. Both buttons must be pressed within 2 minutes.

3. Connecting to the Root AP

Method 2 : With Web Configuration

Step 1. Connect your computer to Wifi Repeater via wireless.

The wireless network (SSID) shall appear as "PLDTHOMEREPEATER".



Note: The Wi-Fi Key or password can be found on the label pasted on Wifi Repeater.

Step 2. Open web browser and type <http://192.168.1.253> in the browser's address box. This is the default IP address for Wifi Repeater.

The default user name is "admin" and password is "1234".
